

Compost Feedstock and On-Farm Management Record

A. Compost Feedstocks

Note that the following are prohibited as compost feedstocks:

- Sewage sludge
- Compost starter and feedstocks fortified with substances not included in this standard or prohibited by par. 1.4 of CAN/CGSB 32.310
- Leather by-products
- Glossy paper
- Waxed cardboard
- Paper containing coloured ink
- Animal, animal products and animal by-products that are not guaranteed free of the risk materials specified in the definition of Bone meal in CAN/CGSB-32.311

**Note that except for animal manures, feedstocks that may be contaminated with substances not included in CAN/CGSB-32.311 or prohibited by par. 1.4 of CAN/CGSB-32.310 shall require documentation to confirm the absence of these substances or documentation substantiating the common degradation of such contaminants during the composting process.
